

ANARCHIST WOMAN REACHES ACROSS THE AISLE

The largest cause of division in this country is the fact that we all have drastically different information diets. In an age where people spend more time consuming media online than talking to people in real life, you are no longer the sum of the 5 people you surround yourself with, but rather the accounts you follow. Leftists don't understand right-wingers, and vice versa. They're being fed different narratives, values, statistics, and terminology. As an anarchist raised in a socially progressive society, but who leans more socially "conservative" myself, I think I can help bridge this communication disconnect.

The problem is that everybody has different, specially tailored algorithms to feed them drastically different content than everybody else. Here's an idea: What if we merged those algorithmic suggestions together? If I'm an anarchist, and I make a video with a fascist, communist, christian nationalist, or a conservative, and upload it to Youtube, then *both* of our audiences will see my anarchist views, and have more anarchist content recommended to them. Likewise, my audience will have more content of opposing views recommended to them as well.

It's not like this is late 1910s Russia in civil war, and we all have bayonets against each other in a physical vie for dominance and control, where the fascists are the white army, the communists are the red army, and the anarchists are the black army. No! We are only online commentators and viewers. We're not shooting at each other. We're only keyboard warriors. There is no good reason for us to NOT interact with each other. Online, we have far more in common with each other, as political "extremists", than we do the disproportionately jewish, pedophile, billionaire scum that make up our ruling class, and the even more pathetic lackeys that defend them. We are all brothers! Your average groyper teenager was raised to be against discrimination, with Christian morality, and is of European descent. The same applies to your average anarchist teenager. In fact, the similarities go even deeper. Both were likely raised middle class, couldn't sit still throughout boring k-12 classes, are most likely the "outspoken" ones in their friend group, and hate being told what to do.

Any young person who cares so much about the society in which he lives, to the point of embracing "political extremism," regardless of the negative social consequences thrust upon him, necessarily holds truth as his highest value. The ruling class does not. We must put an end to needless division online. Gone will be the days where leftists are exclusively fed left-wing content, and right-wingers, right-wing content. Together, everyone will be introduced to everybody else's viewpoints, which will reduce animosity, and help all of accomplish whatever goals we are aiming for. Social change does not happen with a divided population. With any revolutionary movement, it is a small, dedicated minority that makes that change, with the rest of the population being sympathetic to it, or at least not actively fighting against that minority. Merging our social media algorithms would give us this breathing room.

By having everybody exposed to drastically different viewpoints, we will understand each other far better, and even use this as an opportunity to work together toward select shared goals. Together, we expose the real enemy: our tailored outrage algorithms.
